CLOSING CARLETON POND

By direction of the Trustees, a measure will be introduced into the 84th Legislature looking to the closing of Carleton Pond to the public for fishing, ice cutting or other uses. The purpose of this measure is to insure against even a remote possibility of pollution of the water we drink. Such a measure would work no hardship to any person and is in contravention of no public right, for Carleton Pond is secluded and the land around it is owned by the District and fenced. Our splendid water supply is most jealously guarded, and any misuse by the public has long been reduced to a minimum, yet the Trustees will ask for the further safeguard of legally closing the pond to the public for any use whatsoever.
